### Action Taken Report -

1. Sikkim Idol Immersion Rules, 2019 has been notified vide Sikkim Govt. Gazette Extraordinary No. 167 dated 16/04/2019.
2. The Board had published notices in local newspapers before every puja festival season to create awareness among the general public. (Annexure I)
3. The Board after receipt of a copy of the Revised Guidelines for Idol Immersion from CPCB, forwarded it to concerned authorities for the implementation of the same. (Annexure II)

SPCB-Sikkim conducted the pre and post water monitoring for the last 3 years. Assessment Report of the same has been attached herewith as Annexure III.
