OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: On-boarding of industries to the new OCEMS Portal (ODAMS) – reg.

The Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) vide letter No. **IT-11/11/2021-IT-HO-CPCB-HO/5589 dated 23/09/2025** has issued directions under Section 18(1)(b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 18(1)(b) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 regarding on-boarding of industries to the **new OCEMS Portal (ODAMS)** developed by CPCB. The new portal (ODAMS) replaces the earlier OCEMS system and has additional features such as direct transmission of data from industries to CPCB servers, PTZ camera integration, data analytics and visualization, revised calibration protocol, geotagging, and automated alert generation.

1. The matter has been examined in detail by the State Pollution Control Board, Sikkim, and it is hereby informed that the **State of Sikkim does not have 17 category of Highly Polluting Industries (HPI) and Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI)**, as categorized by CPCB.
2. However, the following categories of units operating in the state are required to **register and connect to the new OCEMS Portal (ODAMS)** in compliance with the directions of CPCB:
 1. Hydroelectric Projects (HEPs) having Environmental Flow (E-flow) monitoring;
 2. Sewage Treatment Plants (STPs); and
 3. Captive treatment plants.(BMW incineration facility)
3. All other industrial units may continue with the existing monitoring system as applicable.
4. The units specified in SL No. 2 above requiring migration to the new OCEMS Portal may visit the CPCB website at the given link (i.e <https://cems.cpcb.gov.in>) for registration and follow the procedure available therein.
